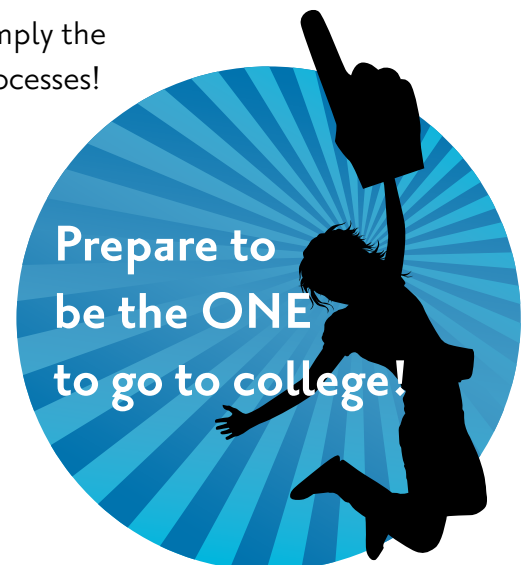
STUDENT ACTIVITY RESUME

There is more to you and the college going process than just academics! Throughout the college and scholarship application process you will be asked to provide information and references about your activities and performance outside of the classroom. Pulling all of this information together for each application can be frustrating. A **student activity resume** is one way to collect this information in an organized manner.

In a student's activity resume, highlight your achievements like awards and leadership positions, extracurricular activities, part-time jobs and special projects and community service experiences. You may use this resume as an aid when completing applications or, when permitted, simply attach it to scholarship forms or letters. It also serves as a quick reference for individuals that you ask to complete a recommendation for you. With this information, they can speak with confidence about your activities and achievements and dates of participation.

Having this information in one place will certainly help simplify the sometimes overwhelming college application and financing processes!
